



SAFETY GUIDELINES FOR RETURN TO CORPORATE WORSHIP

For the safety of our congregation and for respect of our authorities, the following guidelines will be in place as we begin worshipping together on the front lawn.

Service expectations

- What an exciting time to gather again for worship!
- We will offer two opportunities for corporate worship - 9:00 AM and one at 10:30 AM.
- Please understand that like all other things, this is a soft reopening. Things will be different than we have come to expect. Services are requested by CDC to be shorter.
- We will continue to offer video options for those who cannot attend.

Attendance

- If you have not, please indicate your intention to attend in person worship by filling out the short survey online.
- It is recommended that those over 65 or those who have compromised health continue to worship at home.
- If you or anyone in your household has any signs of illness now or recently, please do not attend.

Entering/Exiting

- To avoid mixing with daycare areas, the gates to the playground will remain locked.

Seating

- Please bring your own lawn chair (if able) or blanket to sit on. If not possible, we will have some available.
- A distance of six feet must be kept between different family units.

Children

- We are unable to provide a nursery or children's church at this time.
- Children are welcome to attend, but must remain with their family unit the whole time.

Facilities

- Congregants are encouraged to use restroom facilities before attending services. Restrooms in "the House" will be available for emergency/urgent restroom needs and will be disinfected after each use.
- There will be no hospitality services of any kind; congregants are welcome to bring their own water, coffee, etc.
- The playground will be closed.

Social Distancing Practices

- Per CDC guidelines, masks must be worn at all times.
- Touch-less hand sanitizing stations will be available, but we encourage people to bring and use their own to reduce crowding.
- Please keep socially distant from people not in your family unit

Singing, Scripture and Offering

- Song lyrics and Scriptures will be made available electronically on our church website through a QR code. An email will also go out before the service with the same information. A limited number of song sheets will be made available on site.
- We encourage you to bring your own Bible.
- Offering baskets will be placed at stations in back of worship area to avoid passing the plate.
